



Breathe Partners Ministries Ministry Team Agreement

We are delighted when people want to serve in Ministry positions at Breathe Partners Ministries. All who serve are asked to agree to the following standards of preparation, teamwork, and life so that our unity and common purpose are both genuine and visible to all.

While there may be other requirements for certain ministries, this agreement is a minimum qualification designed to identify all the people who are growing believers in Jesus Christ, who qualify to serve in the various ministries of Breathe Partners Ministries. All who are a part of the Breathe Partners Ministries agree to the following values:

PREPARATION:

- A. Be sure of their faith in Christ and have an basic knowledge of the mission, its theology, policies, and direction.
- B. Be willing to participate in appropriate training necessary for effective service. This may include training for a particular position.
- C. Have a desire to use the position to minister to people effectively for the sake of Jesus Christ by faithful preparation and consistent involvement.
- D. Understand the beliefs, direction, and policies of the mission.

TEAMWORK:

- A. While there may be differing opinions on various issues of lesser importance, those in ministry agree to work as a team toward the same goals.
- B. Be faithful to the mission in terms of making others aware of services and giving as able.
- C. Participate in Ministry Team meetings, as appropriate, carry out assignments, and support other Ministry Team members.
- D. Work in harmony with Breathe Partners Ministries leadership, those who lead the area of ministry, and within your specific ministry description.

LIFE:

- A. Pursue a plan for continued personal Christian growth.
- B. Demonstrate harmony with your family and other Christians (Eph. 5:22-6:4) and seek to correct problems in keeping with Biblical guidelines. (Matt. 5 & 18).
- C. Demonstrate godly, Christian living in the community by being "blameless" (as described in I Tim. 3:2). Blameless living does not mean being perfect, but it does indicate openly living for Jesus with a heart for people and an avoidance of questionable pursuits.
